



## Action taken Report

### Feedback Analysis

2023-24

Based on the feedback analysis, it has been found that 145 courses out of total 168 courses (including both B. Pharm. and M. Pharm.) attained 3.0 out of 3.0 and the concerned faculty members were congratulated.

23 courses were found to have attainment less than 3.0. out of them 18 courses have been found to have a good course satisfaction (more than 80%) however lesser attainment that is 0, 1 or 2. It indicates the teaching of the course may be improved and concerned faculty have been counselled to use more interesting teaching learning techniques, assignments, usage of modern teaching aids and such enhanced tools for better teaching learning.

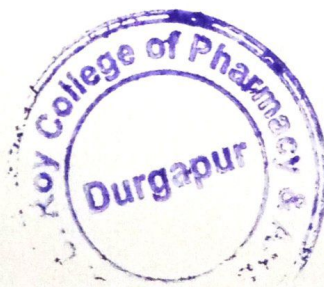
The remaining 5 courses have been found to have less than 80% satisfaction as well as lesser attainment such as 0, 1, 2. For these courses, the university needs to be contacted to undertake any discussion about the course curriculum (We have already sent gaps and related gap analysis to the affiliating university (MAKAUT) in 2022 for all such courses. This time the university has been communicated again verbally for such courses, and for the attainment, the teachers are encouraged to use more interesting teaching aids, emphasize on student interactions, their understanding and problem solving abilities. As another remediating measure, tutorial classes also have been included in the class routine.

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
